

## How can students use **online** primary sources?

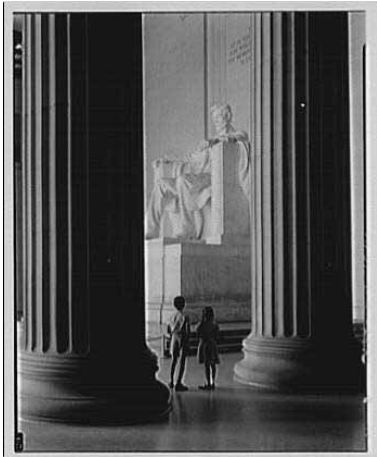

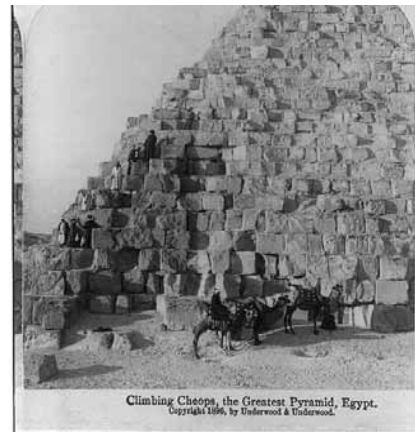
